How is the opioid epidemic affecting you, your family, and your neighborhood?:

I developed an eating disorder when I was 13 and suffered with drugs and alcohol abuse until I went into recovery in July 20, 2013. I married a man who is an addict. Together we had two beautiful girls. The relationship was toxic and abusive. I II don't know where he is now and am partially very glad. My girls are finally happy and so am I.

What do you see as causes of the epidemic in your community and in Ohio?:

We suffer from low self-worth and no coping skills

What steps might we take as a state to combat the opioid epidemic?:

I am a yoga teacher today and I teach children. I want to prevent kids from feeling as I did growing up.

What might we do as individuals and a community to reduce opioid abuse?:

Teach children coping skills and bring yoga into schools. We used to mask how we felt.
